



Do You Know Where Your Electricity Comes From?

As required by law, each year the **Lodi Electric Utility** prepares and submits its **Power Content Label** - an annual report that shows where your electricity was generated during the calendar year and how it compares to the State of California's power mix.

Lodi's power mix meets California's requirements for clean energy with more than 30 percent of Lodi's power mix coming from eligible renewable resources.
